Tuesday - Acts 1:12-26

- 1. Is there any significance to women being present in the upper-room prayer meeting?
- 2. Who is emerging as the leader?
- 3. What was the criteria for choosing a new apostle?
- 4. Is there a significance to the number 12?

Wednesday – Acts 2

- 1. What happened in the first 3 verses?
- 2. Acts 1:8 told us to go where? Contrast that with Acts 2:5
- 3. Why were they all confused and amazed?
- 4. What are some key points to Peter's sermon?
- 5. When asked "Men and brethren, what shall we do?" What was Peter's response? Have you done those two things?
