1. Who wrote the Acts of the Apostles?
2. He begins with “The former account...” What is he talking about?
3. Why were they told to wait in Jerusalem?
4. To what if verse 11 referring?

Tuesday – Acts 1:12-26

1. Is there any significance to women being present in the upper-room prayer meeting?
2. Who is emerging as the leader?
3. What was the criteria for choosing a new apostle?
4. Is there a significance to the number 12?

Wednesday – Acts 2

1. What happened in the first 3 verses?
2. Acts 1:8 told us to go where? Contrast that with Acts 2:5
3. Why were they all confused and amazed?
4. What are some key points to Peter’s sermon?
5. When asked “Men and brethren, what shall we do?” What was Peter’s response? Have you done those two things?
6. How does the description of the early church in verse 40-47 compare with your church?

Thursday – Acts 3:1-10

1. Where were Peter and John going? What were they going to do?
2. How was it possible that Peter was able to heal the lame man in verse 6?
3. What was the result of the lame man’s healing?

Friday – Acts 3:11-26

1. Who does Peter attribute the healing to? (Verse 16)
2. Does Peter allow them to continue in ignorance?
3. To whom did God send His Servant/Son first?
